

Residential Fees and Charges

Clayton Church Homes provides accommodation to residential aged care clients in line with the accommodation pricing structure detailed in the relevant legislations and as adjusted by the Department of Health from time to time.

From 1 July 2014, Refundable Accommodation Deposits (RAD) and Daily Accommodation Payments (DAP) were introduced by the Department of Health into aged care. All eligible residents are charged a RAD or a combination of a RAD and a DAP or a DAP.

- **Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD)** - a lump sum style accommodation payment. The balance of the deposit is refunded when you leave residential care less any amounts you have agreed to have deducted.
- **Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP)** - instead of paying for residential accommodation as a lump sum you can choose to pay as a period payment. The amount you pay is based on a daily rate as agreed with your service provider.
- **RAD/DAP Combination Payment** - a combined part Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD) and a non refundable Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP).

Accommodation payments will be discussed with the resident or their appropriate representative prior to admission.

Part of charging a RAD requires the allocation and publishing of the Refundable Accommodation Deposit payable for each room. Refer to CCH Accommodation Pricing Structure for further information regarding Clayton Church Homes' accommodation charges.
